To provide an overview of the international legislative position a further chapter, also written by the regulatory team at Leatherhead, reviews the approach of major countries and trading blocs worldwide.

Food additive legislation within the EU has changed greatly in the past 50 years and this fourth edition of the Guide includes an insightful chapter on these developments by Dr. David Jukes of Reading University.

With extensive references this expert Guide is an essential introduction for those wishing to understand the role of additives in food.
